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Dr. Ennis has extensive experience and expertise in developing and disseminating evidence-based interventions for those coping with chronic and/or life-limiting illnesses. Her research agenda has spanned the translation spectrum from the from T1, clinical efficacy of interventions to T3, dissemination and implementation of interventions, addressing gaps in healthcare through multi-level, multi-target interventions across a range of chronic and/or life limiting conditions such as HIV, cancer, and chronic pain.

Dr. Nicole Ennis is an Associate Professor in the Department of Behavioral Sciences and Social Medicine in the College of Medicine at Florida State University. She is the Director of the iR.A.C.E. (Intervention Research Advancing Care Equity) Lab. Dr. Ennis is also an Affiliate Faculty member in the Department of Clinical and Health Psychology at the University of Florida and is a member of the Advisory Board for the Southern HIV Alcohol Research Consortium (SHARC).
